

Minutes of the extraordinary meeting of Old Hurst Parish Council
held in The Church of St. Peter on Monday 3rd September 2018.

Councillors present: Mr. G. Bull, Mrs. J. Mackenzie, Mr. I. Martin, Mrs. L. Sawyer (Chairman)
& Mrs. E. Taylor.

Also present: Mrs. D. Benham (Parish Clerk) & 3 parishioners.

Public participation – The parishioners present raised concerns about drainage and road safety with regard to planning application ref. 18/01661/FUL.

1. **Apologies for absence:** Cllr. C. Bussetil.

2. **Declarations of interest:** All councillors present declared that they knew the applicant of the planning application to be discussed, but all declared that they did not have a pecuniary interest.

3. **Planning application ref. 18/01661/FUL Erection of 2no. pair of semi-detached dwellings, associated garages and means of access. Land North East of Mulfield House, The Lane, Old Hurst.**

Councillors discussed the application and considered the concerns raised by the parishioners present and a letter of objection received from a neighbour of the site. Cllr. Martin proposed that Old Hurst Parish Council recommend approval of the application but highlight road safety concerns and existing drainage issues. Seconded by Cllr. Mackenzie and unanimously agreed.
