held in The Church of St. Peter on Wednesday 7th November 2018.

Public participation – There were no parishioners present.

1. **Apologies for absence:** Cllr. I. Martin (personal), Cllr. C. Bussetil (personal).

2. **To receive declarations of interest:** None received.

3. **To discuss and agree the comments to be returned on the further information received regarding Planning Application ref. 18/01661/FUL. Erection of 2 no. pair of semi-detached dwellings, associated garages and means of access. Land north east of Mulfield House, the Lane, Old Hurst.**

Clerk to return the following comments: Councillors agree that the new dwelling would be better set further back to allow for increased parking spaces for each property. Councillors do not agree that there should be three separate entrance/exit points on to The Lane and feel that the original plan, that had one shared driveway access to the right hand side of the site, would be best in terms of road safety. Councillors also wished to emphasize that there is a known drainage issue and that the ditch between Mulfield House and the site needs to be dug out and then piped along the front of the site to join with the existing drainage pipe, which goes across and under the road.
